RESPECT

- The right to privacy of your fellow members
- The rights of members and your on-line community to be free of harassing, disparaging and pornographic materials verbally, on computers or on the Internet
- The physical space, property and computer equipment
- Respect for Staff, Volunteers and fellow Members at all times.

HONESTY AND INTEGRITY

- No illegal copying, distribution or reselling of software
- No destruction of property
- **No access to pornographic sites or related material (Strictly Prohibited)**

PEACEFUL COMMUNITY

- No weapons, drugs or alcohol
- Share information and offer assistance when asked
- Limit your use of computers when other members are waiting
- Please move outside or to the front of the office if you get a cell phone call

SECURITY AND VIGILANCE

- Anticipate problems before they happen
- Report any problems such as spills, broken equipment or furniture, vandals, etc.
- No diskettes or CD's can be brought into CyberSpace without the approval of staff
- No sending of junk mail or email spam
- No interfering with the performance of any of the computers or networks
- No sharing of Member ID's and passwords
- No unauthorized access to computers or networks,
- No use of software, tools or scripts that might interfere with local, network or terminal sessions or intercept any data not intended for you, including the Center's web site
- No downloading or installing of computer programs of any kind(**Strictly Prohibited**)
